Confirmed, the sole purpose is to better understand and inform the evaluation of the proposed LMS technology solution; per Section 5.2 of the ITP, the session presents an opportunity for in-person demonstration of the proposed technology and for clarification of the information provided in Proposers' Proposals. It will have no bearing on other aspects of the Proposal evaluation. The agenda is up to the presenters, the only guidance is that at least 30 mins of the allotted 90 mins be reserved for Q&A, intros and company overviews be limited to 5 mins, and the presentation content be tailored to offer participants a clearer understanding of the functionality, features, and LMS implementation plan included in the Proposal. As much as possible content should be specific to the Smart Lighting solution and not a general sales presentation. A demonstration of an existing system is preferable, but a virtual demonstration of a simulated Chicago installation is also acceptable.
